

Huguenots, Scarsdale And Tigers In Lead

All 11 top-seeded wrestlers made it through yesterday's default-riddled first and quarter-final rounds of the 1959 Section One Scholastic Wrestling Championships at Fox Lane High.

The No. 1 men are Neslie Gunthrope of New Rochelle Ted Lansky of Scarsdale, Pete Carissimi of White Plains, Oli Davis of New Rochelle, Charlie Hayes of Sleepy Hollow, Larry Gladieux of Scarsdale, John Bracey of New Rochelle Cordell, Berman of New Rochelle, Tom Rogers of White Plains, Bob Horton of White Plains and Bill Wright of Scarsdale, from the light to the heavy of it. Carissimi, Hayes and Gladieux are defending champions in their respective divisions.

After the grapplers had finally cleared the three mats, New Rochelle, beaten only by White Plains in this year's dual meeting doing, was tied for the team lead with Scarsdale and White Plains, co-champions last year. The leaders had six points apiece.

Northern Westchester champion Fox Lane had five, Lakeland, two, Yorktown, Rye, Sleepy Hollow, John Jay and Lincoln of Yonkers each one.

When the boys took to the mats for the final two championship rounds and the consolation round at noon today at Fox Lane, New Rochelle had nine entrants left, Scarsdale eight, White Plains, seven, Fox Lane six, Yorktown, and Rye each three, Lakeland two, Hendrick Hudson, Sleepy Hollow John Jay, Horace Greeley, Mahopac and Lincoln one apiece.

The talk of the meet was Lincoln High's one-man team Ted Cosmos, previously unseen on Section One scholastic mats. The fast and apparently very strong 1959 Metropolitan AAU Development Project 191-pound and heavy-weight champ and 191 pound champion of the 1958 Randall's Island Junior Olympics had never wrestled other than Greco Roman style, in which the sole object is merely to take an opponent off his feet. Inexperienced out of the stand-up position, Cosmos was good enough to pin Hendrick Hudson's Mike Burns two minutes into the second period and then flatten White Plains' third-seeded heavy, Mel Greenhill, in 34 seconds.

The fastest pin of the day was Arch Umstead's 26-second stacking of Dobbs Ferry's Mike Goodson for New Rochelle.
