Dear Parents, Wrestlers, and Friends,

The 1999-2000 season was quite a rollercoaster ride. The team started strong, faded in the middle, and turned it back on in the end.

This year we have to say goodbye to two seniors, Kyle Tellex and Steve McElvain. Both boys have helped Fairport establish a strong wrestling program. Their leadership, hard work, and dedication to the sport of wrestling will be greatly missed.

Next season eleven starters will return to compete for Fairport. That number is incredible! Six of those boys return with winning records and the other five are improving every match.

Super Sectional qualifier Phil Accorso will return for his freshman year and should be a threat again. Mike Fuqua and John LaClair will be juniors and will be looking for solid seasons as they go for their third year of varsity competition. Brain Bowen and Justin Gavin will be back as juniors for their second year on the varsity. Ian Ammons will be back as a junior for his third year on the varsity. Next year's seniors will be powerful. Returning on the varsity level are Matt Cunningham for his third year, Steve Hassett for his third year, and Ryan Kelly for his second year. Also Justin Cunningham will make a permanent move to the varsity from JV competition. Joe Fingler, a Super Sectional qualifier this season will be returning as a junior to start his fourth year of varsity competition.

The numbers do not lie, our 2000-2001 team will have a lot of experienced and talented young men. We have already talked about it and our goal is an East League Championship. If they apply themselves, wrestle in the off-season, and hit the weights, then the goals they have should be attainable.

Our JV squad had another fine season under the direction of Coach Gary Dawes. The team went 6-3-1 in duals and was second as a team at the JV Counties. This second place finish is a very high honor with only wrestling powerhouse Spencerport beating us out of the top honors.

Earning All-County honors were Nick Ryan, Nick Seaman, Dan Safranec, Dan Rowe, Aaron Semler, Ryan Good, and Justin Cunningham. Others that competed for Eairport were Eric Kohl, Joe Wingate, Adam Zurbruegg, Bill Kenny, Shawn Beach, and Alex Peck. These boys should be very proud of their second place finish. John Cloonan, Josh Sweet, and Joe Wurtenberg also competed on the JV squad.

Many of these boys will be challenging for a varsity position next season. Plus this year's crop of eighth graders is a strong one and Coach Dawes' team should be in the hunt for a high finish again next year.

Wrestling is an extremely hard sport that requires the efforts and dedication of all involved: coaches, family, athletic staff, teachers, and even the neglected family pets. But most of all it is difficult for the young men who give up their afternoons, weekends, and even an occasional meal. They do this in order to achieve something, of course the overall goal is to win but their success should not only be measured by their wins. These guys have heart. They made it through another season or perhaps their first. This may sound easy for some but it is not easy for all.

One young wrestler came to Coach Dawes and me early in the year and said he didn't think this sport was for him. That night we talked on the phone and he said he would try it for another week. Three months later he was competing at the JV Counties. This young man to me is the definition of having heart and desire. He may not have had his hand raised as a champion but to my staff and me he is nothing but a champion.

So to my staff, the families and all involved I thank you for a great year and remember to tell these young men how proud you are of them. Not everyone can say they wrestled.






Kyle Tellex 140, Senior, Captain, All-League Honorable Mention Varsity Record: 18–8

Varsity Record: 14-15






Brian Baniewicz 140/145/152, Junior, Captain


Varsity Record: 8-8

Steve Hassett 152/160, Junior


Varsity Record: 13-14



Ryan stepped into the varsity role for the first time this season. It was also only Ryan's second year in the sport. With more experience Ryan should be a threat next season as a heavyweight.






Mike Fuqua 112, Sophomore, All-League Honorable Mention




John LaClair 119, Sophomore Varsity Record: 6–20




Brian Bowen 135, Sophomore


Varsity Record: 19-16


Ian Ammons 145, Sophomore Varsity Record: 20–13


Ryan Good 145, Sophomore



Joe Fingler 171/189, Sophomore, Captain, All-League Honorable Mention

Varsity Record: 27-11

Joe had his breakthrough season this year. He was able to place in all but one tournament he entered including winning two. He won the Campbell-Savona Tournament and the Penfield Holiday Tournament back-to-back. He placed second at the prestigious Clayton Barnard Tournament and earned All-County honors by finishing fifth at the Monroe County Tournament. Nick Seaman 119, Freshman JV Record: 19–9


