

The team had several great performances from freshmen this year. Todd Zimmerman was City-Catholic Champion this year, Joe Digregorio finished second at the C-C, Irondequoit and Vestal tournaments. Also, John Condello finished fourth at the Churchville-Chili tournament and second at the C-C tournament. In addition, Chris Vaccaro, Sam Lombardo, Adam Lippa, Chris Matteson, Brian Crosby, and Mark Agnello all brought in wins.

The sophomores made vast improvements in performance. Jerry Lopez was the Churchville-Chili tournament Champion. Dave Bill was the Churchville-Chili
