

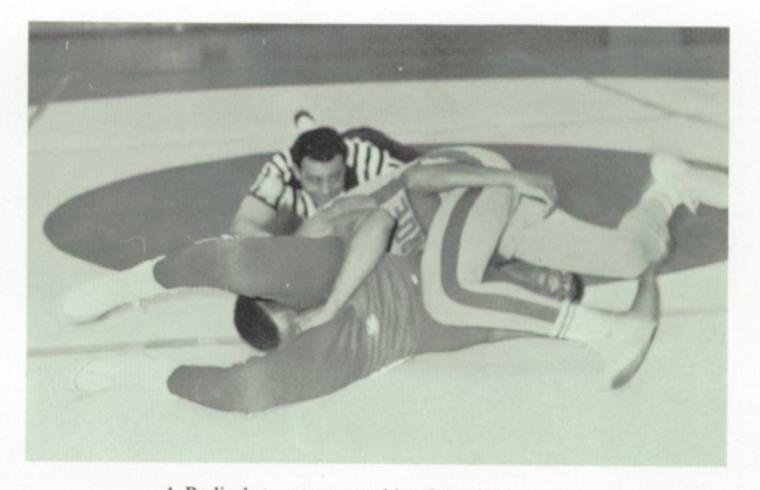

Wrestling

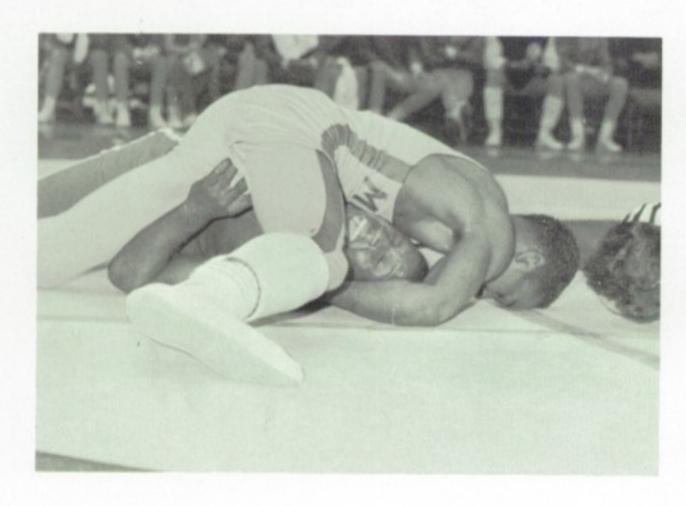
