#### **Don DeBadts**

The Livingston wrestling community is saddened by the death this Fall of Don DeBadts, long-time icon of wrestling in Geneseo, the LCAA League, Section V and New York State. Don moved to Geneseo in 1968 and began his career there as a math teacher. Don was the assistant wrestling coach in 1968 and took over as head coach in 1969. His career included 2 LCAA tournament championships, 3 dual meet championships, and 2 Section V Class championships. Numerous wrestlers won LCAA and Section V class titles. 2 wrestlers qualified for the NYS State tournament; Andy Lipson, 1972 and Kevin Richard, 3rd in 1978. In 1970, the Genesee Valley Wrestling Tournament was instituted by Don and grew from an 8 team event to over 30 teams competing for individual and team titles. Many interesting stories were generated by the events of those weekends.

Don's contribution to local wrestling included many varied activities. He joined the Wrestling Officials Association (WOA) in 1968, officiating until 2000. He was the President of WOA '87-'89 and served on many WOA committees (Executive, Ethics, Coach of the Year, Bernabi Award) at various times.

In 1993, Don became Section V Chairman serving until 2003. Don's leadership continued the growth of local wrestling into a leading competitive Section

in New York State. He guided Section V through many changes; adding weight classes, streamlining tournament format, and modifying qualification guidelines for sectional tournaments were among the many improvements Don coordinated.

Don continued his service to New York State wrestling by being appointed as the NYS Wrestling Chairman in 2003, serving until 2008. While at the helm of the State program, Don originated and instituted separate classes for large and small schools. This format instantly doubled the number of contestants wrestling for State titles. Each weight class included 16 man brackets competing for the honor of a State championship. NYSPHSAA was also extremelu impressed with the new format since it doubled crowd size and significantly increased ticket sales, making the NYS Tournament the highest grossing weekend sporting event for NYSPHSAA. After moving around many venues in the State, New York State Wrestling has found a home at the Albany Times Union Arena where it sells out yearly.

For his diligent work and dedication, Don was honored many times. He was inducted into the LCAA Wrestling Hall of Fame in 1993. In 2003, he was inducted into the Section V Wrestling Hall of Fame and into the Upstate NY Chapter of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame located in Stillwater, Ok. His fourth honor was induction into the NYS Wrestling Hall of Fame in 2008.

### Don was also honored for his contribution to local wrestling with the following awards:

- Life member of WOA of Sec. V (2002)
- Bernabi Award (1989) for outstanding contributions to wrestling officials
- Justice Award (2009) for outstanding contributions to Section V wrestling
- One of the founders of Friends of Section V Wrestling (FOW)
- Served as an evaluator at the NCAA Div. I Tournament

As a friend, fellow official, coach, parent and supporter of wrestling, we are all thankful for Don's efforts to improve, teach, and publicize the sport of wrestling.





(emphasis on wrestling), modified wrestling coach Avon 1985 & '86, historian for Avon wrestling, 4 sons wrestled at Avon (2 in LCAA HOF), initiated the Trevor Regan Service Award in 2015, ardent supporter of Avon, LCAA & Sec V wrestling. Awards: Sec V Terry Justice Memorial award 1986, Avon Athletic Assoc. Hall of Fame inductee for service to youth of Avon 2016.
