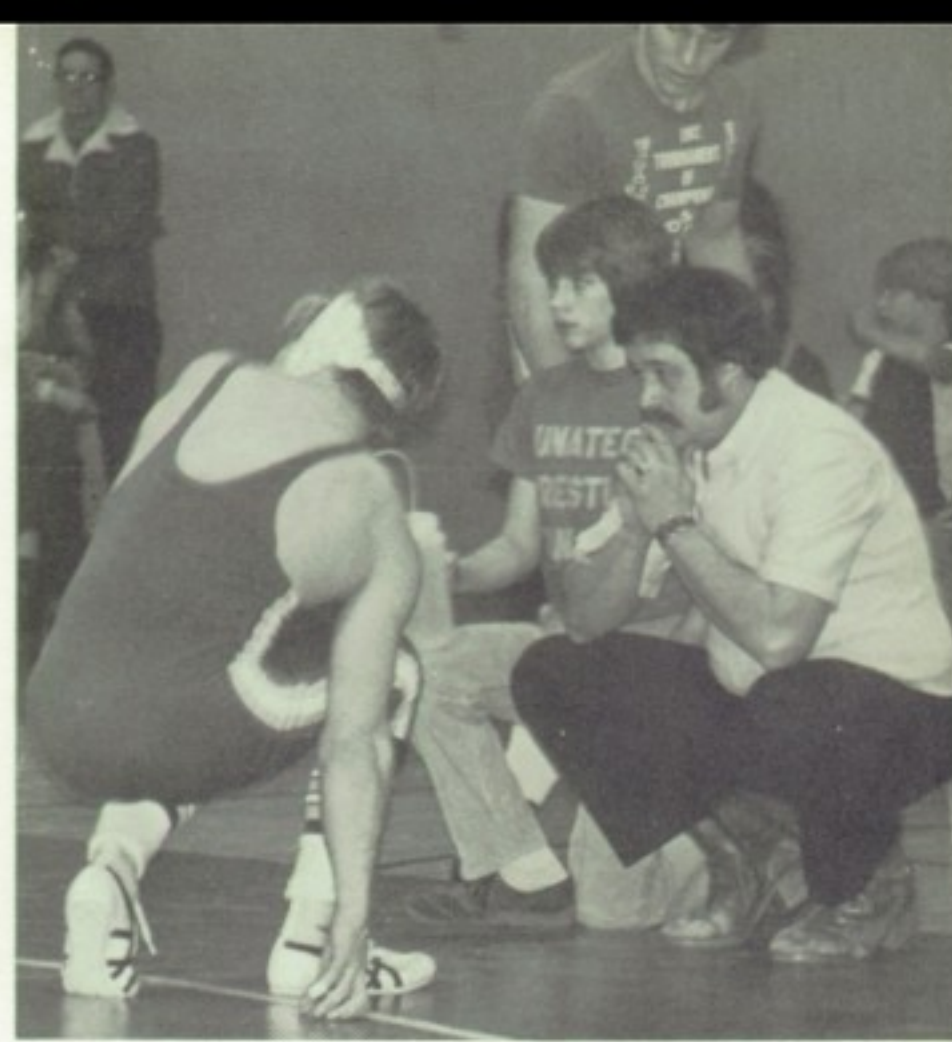
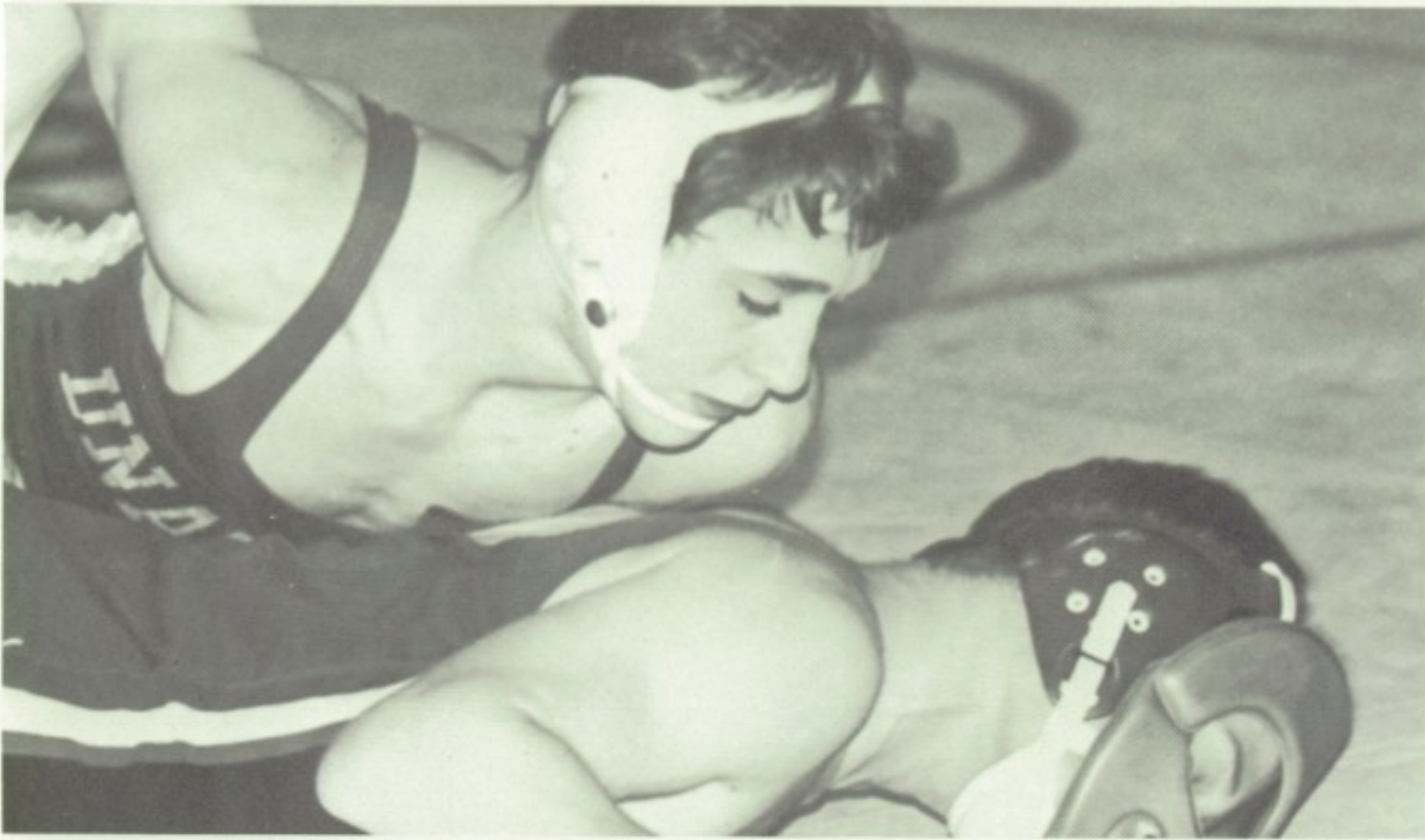

Unatego can be proud of its wrestlers who represented Section Four at the New York State Intersectional Tournament in Syracuse. Dan Peterson competed for the third straight year. He failed to place but did pin his opponent from the Buffalo area to close the season with a 33-2 record. His career victories totaled more than 100 over the past five years. Steve Hall completed an excellent season by placing third in the unlimited weight class. He defeated opponent from the Catholic schools, Section 6, Section 2, and Section 10. Steve lost his semi-final match to the eventual state champion, 5-1. Steve compiled a 34-2 record. Don Peterson returned to the state tournament for a second straight year. He moved up to the 167 pound weight class and became Unatego's first finalist. Don earned his way to the finals by defeating boys from Section 9, the PSAL, and Section 5. Don lost in the final 5-3 after suffering a broken nose in the first period.
