Southwestern's Mike Coon placed second in the 157-lb. class, moving to the finals with a 3:15 first-round pin on Williamsville's Dennis Brown. In the give-and-take finals, Coon was nailed at 5:47 by Mike Crandall of Medina after nearly pinning the eventual winner.

Crandall was sectional champ two years ago, losing out last year by one point in the finals. He carried a 16-0 record into his match with Coon.

Consolation round winners from the Southern Tier were Jim Lucas of Pine Valley, Tim Witherell of Gowanda, and Bill Salisbury of Cattaraugus.

Silver Creek's Chuck Cornwall had to forfeit his consolation match with Dan Kathan of Williamsville after suffering a first-round injury.

Larry Steinbar, Cattaraugus, entered the meet with a perfect record but finished fourth after losing to Brown in the consolations.

All winners travel as a team to the state tourney to compete against winners from other sections.
