

OAKFIELD WRESTLERS WIN G-O LOOP TITLE

Gypsum Villagers Take Seven Firsts, Albion Captures Five.

LYNDONVILLE IS THIRD

The Oakfield-Alabama Central School wrestling team won the Genesee-Orleans championship at Oakfield Saturday. Coach George Messinger's defending champions were pushed hard by able Albion bone crushers who learn their tricks from Coach Mike Spierdowis.

Oakfield took seven first places and Albion five. Coach Arnold Hartsen's Lyndonville musclemen clinched third place while Ken Harris and his Holley grapplers took fourth place.

The tournament was packed with action in both the afternoon semifinals and the evening finals. Robert Bell, Holley's defending 120-pound champ, was pinned by John Klopp of Albion and 127-pound Donald Petote, also defending champ from Holley, was decided by George Plummer of Albion.

Roger McGee of Oakfield retained his title by taking a decision from Richard Canham of Albion in the unlimited class.

The winners in each weight class will tangle with the Wyoming County tournament winners to decide a team to enter the Rochester sectional tournament to be held April 7.

The final score was Oakfield-Alabama 60, Albion 54, Lyndonville 29 and Holley 19.
