



State Rated Wrestling Teams Test Bombers Here Saturday

Four major New York State wrestling schoolboy teams show their talent here Saturday night with East Rochester hosting Olean, Canandaigua, and Sweet Home of Buffalo.

The twin bill follows a Monroe County Eastern Division match here Friday night against Rush Sperry. Both the Jayvee and varsity teams will take to the mats at 7 p.m.

Next Thursday night, East Rochester hosts Sutherland in a league argument and then comes the big one of the season, the Bombers at Fairport, Saturday night, Feb. 11 with action underway at 6:30 (jayvees) and 8:30 (varsity).

In Saturday night's doubleheader, the menu opens with East Rochester taking on Sweet Home on one mat and Canandaigua clashing with Olean on the second.

In the second matches, the Bombers and Olean collide on one mat; and Sweet Home and Canandaigua on the other. The attractions will lure the season's largest gallery here this season. First scrap is at 6:30 p.m.; the second at 8 p.m.

The day will be spiced by action between the rival Jayvee teams in the same order of competition. First match is at 11 a.m. and the second at 1 p.m.

East Rochester moves into the tough doubleheader after registering two more weekend wins.

Coach Don Quinn's Bombers ripped past Eastridge in a County East match last Saturday night here, 54-6 and topped the victory off with a 47-9 nod over Bishbp Kearney.

One Bomber won two matches earlier in the day over the visiting school jayvee teams and donned ER livery to add a varsity verdict. Mike Kuhn decisioned Kearney's John DeNero, 10-4



Mike Brien won a pair of 98 pound arguments via the pin route. He finished Remo Pasquarella of Eastridge in 3:52 and John Bellomio of Kearney in 51 seconds.

Four Bombers gained forfeit wins in the Eastridge matches. Curtis Doreen in the 105 class; undefeated John Zito at 167; Joe Baldo at 215 and Rick Consaul at 177.

Doreen tallied a 4:32 pin over Kearney matman Jon Dormoil; Zito wiped out Ed Mica in 52 seconds; Baldo flattened Paul Effert in 4:57 and Consaul decisioned Rick Ianello, 7-5.

Romeo Battazzi, one of Quinn's future powers gained two victories in the 112 division. Rick Pagano of Eastridge was a pin victim in 5:38 and Kearney's Stero Stadlmiller fell, 14-2.

Mike McAuliffe at 119 split a pair of decisions winning by a default over Eastridge's Idris Kadercan and losing 2-1 to Joe Alvarez of BK.

In the 132 class, Bomber Dave Yacona bowed to Eastridge's Garth Rehberg, 8-7; and pinned John Grangeld of Kearney in 2:50.

Bob Marianetti of ER lost both 138 tilts. The first to Dan Mancini of Eastridge, 12-6; and the second to Kearney's Bill Adams, 11-7.

Bruce Kier took a 145 pound clash over Tom Schakow of Eastridge, 9-7 and lost to Greg Ellendt of BK, 8-3.

Dave Prong at 155 was a 6-4 victor over Eastridge matman Gene Morrealle and Kevin Maynard pinned John Malarz of Kearney in 3:16.
