City Individual Tests Begin Tonight

Madison High School's solid six—half a dozen young wrestlers who can't spell defeat—led the Wilson Parkers to an unbeaten Interscholastic Wrestling League season and the city championship with a 31-12 win at Monroe yesterday.

Actually, Madison had the title all but wrapped up last week, but this extra win was a gift to first-year coach Roy McLean.

McLean, an assistant at East for three years, now will take his 12-man squad into the city individual championship, scheduled tonight and tomorrow evening at Franklin.

Matches will be held starting at 7 tonight. Tomorrow evening the finals will be run off. Each of the nine I. L. schools may put one man in each class, with the eventual champions to represent the city in Section 5 competition which begins March 2 at Webster's R. L. Thomas School.

West, unbeaten in league competition until last Friday when Madison shutout the Occidentals, finished second in the standings with a 7-1 record. East and Jeff followed at 5 and 3.

West's unbeaten big six kept their records intact yesterday, Neil Rivaldo leading the way with a 4-0 decision against Monroe's previously undefeated Cliff Swick. The victory was Rivaldo's ninth of the season.

Bob McFarland won his ninth at 106 pounds, Frank Lauricella made it six straight at 112 pounds; Dave Baker won his fifth at 123 pounds; Don Powers won his ninth in the 127-pound class; and Dwight Rhodes scored No. 9 at 182. Monroe's Roy Washington (145 pounds) and Dietmar Bachman (157) also finished undefeated.
