


ITHACA IS HAVING A GREAT SEASON

Coach John Murray's Ithaca
College wrestlers are undefeated
going into tonight's contest and
have a showdown at University of
Buffalo tomorrow night that should
determine the number one squad in
Division III.

126 pound Joel Lamson won the championship of his weight class at the RIT Invitational in December.
142 pound Ron Gross started out the season by winning the Cornell Open and the Ithaca Invitational in November. 158 pound Mikey Cronmiller took the title in the Cornell Open in November and won the New York State championship for his weight class in January.

All New York State honors also went to Joel Lamson, Ron Gross, Tim Habecker, Dan Bieller, Mike Fusilli and Rich Kane.

The Bombers won convincingly over Trenton State when the latter was ranked first in the nation for Division III. Ithaca won a heartstopping meet over cross-town rival Cornell, sparked by pins from Marty Nichols and Mike Fusilli.

Ithaca's closest meet so far was a win over St. Lawrence last weekend.

RIT WRESTLING DOING WELL

Coach Earl Fuller's Rochester Institute of Technology wrestling team has shown great improvement in the 1987-88 season. The Tigers are young and spirited and the future looks bright.

Two wrestlers - Kevin Sampson and Chris Madden - have received RIT Athlete of the Week honors this winter. Sampson earned fourth place at 145 lbs. in the RIT Invitational in December. Curt Jenkins gained All New York State honors in January, placing sixth at 158 lbs.

Virtually all of the Tigers have improved their records over last year and many have pulled upsets against highly regarded opponents. RIT is 3-5 going into tonight's meet with victories over Binghamton, Cortland and Potsdam.
