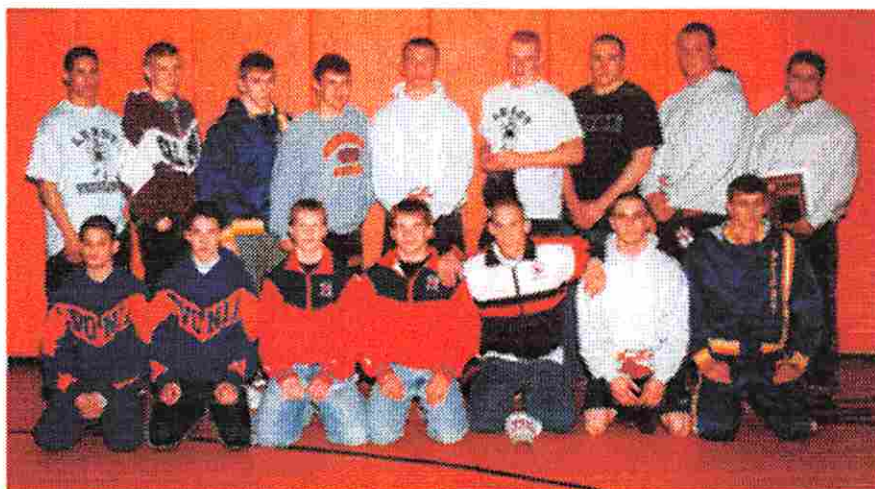

The 42<sup>nd</sup> annual Livingston Conference Wrestling Tournament could have some new teams reigning at the conclusion of wrestling on Saturday night. The Homell Red Raiders, in their second year of competition in the LCAA, won the Div I dual meet title and are favored to win the team tournament title. The top challengers this year will be D-I runner-up Caledonia-Mumford and D-II powerhouses Letchworth and Pavilion.

Seven champions from 1999 return to defend their titles this season. Kyle Ciancio, Livonia (103), Dan Dutton, Livonia (119), Ryan Alexander, LeRoy (140), James Beaumont, Caledonia (152), Shane Rimmer, Perry (160), David Leitten, Warsaw (275), and Blaine Broughton, Letchworth (135) will defend against tough challengers.

Coach Matt Sheldon and the Homell Red Raiders bring a balanced line-up to the tournament. Defending LCAA and Section V champion Mike Smith, Sr. (119) returns to lead the Red Raiders. Smith is on a quest to return to the New York State tournament and is favored to win his second consecutive LCAA title. Other Homell standouts are Cory Lawrence Fr. (140); Cliff McMichael, Sr. (171); Brian Egger, Jr. (125); and Brian Doty, Sr. (215).

The Caledonia Red Raiders, coached by John Wilbur, are again a force in the LCAA after re-building the program. After losing the dual meet title to Homell, the Caledonia matmen will be seeking revenge and win the first tournament title since 1975. Leading the Red Raiders will be Tim Jones, Sr. (103); Willie Jones, Sr. (189); James Beaumont, Jr. (152); Tony D'Ambra, Jr. (130); Chad Robinson, Soph. (135); and Greg Brown, Soph. (112).

The Letchworth Indians could be the surprise champion if they are on top of their game. Coach Matt Wilkins will send a corp of seasoned veterans to compete for the top. Seniors Dan Osborn (152) and Blaine Broughton (135) lead the charge. Looking to win for the Indians will be Adam Jines, Jr. (119); Nate Osborn, Soph. (130); Phil Sovocol, Sr. (140); Derek Sweet, 8<sup>th</sup> (96); Brandon Treat, Jr. (125); and Jeff Abbott, Sr. (215).

The Pavilion Golden Gophers have successfully transformed a quick turn around to challenge for top honors. Coach Troy Almeter will send defending Section V champion Lucas Flint, Jr. (189) to nail down a championship and lead Pavilion. Supporting his efforts will be Greg Appleton, Sr. (145); Cory Beardsley, Sr. (112); Rob Blakeslee, Jr. (125), Greg Mastin, Jr. (160); and Aaron Strobel, Sr. (135).

A top five finish is definitely in the cards for the host Wayland-Cohocton Eagles. Coach Mike Swan has five tough veterans to send on the mat. Perennial standout Tim Page, Sr. (112) will be trying for the fourth LCAA title of his career. Sam Wolcott, Sr. (171); Pat Swan, Sr. (140); Craig Stauffer, Soph. (112); and Dan Mehlenbacher, Jr. (130) will lead the Way-Co charge.

The Livonia Bulldogs have a number of outstanding wrestlers vying for a LCAA Crown. Returning champions Kyle Ciancio, Jr. (103) and Dan Dutton, Soph. (119) lead coach Cris Genthner's Bulldogs. Senior Josh Love is having an outstanding season at (125). Branden Green Jr. (130) and Sam Weintraub Sr. (160) should place for Livonia.

Other wrestlers who should place will be:

From Warsaw, Dave Leitten Sr., a 2 time LCAA champion and 2 time Section V champion should easily defend his crown at 275. Sophomore Pete Flint (96) is favored at his weight class. Eamon Lyons, Sr. (130) and Chris Reger, Soph. (171) can place for Coach Al Goodenow.

Perry is paced by Senior Shane Rimmer (160). Other Yellowjacket wrestlers who should place for coach Andy Englert are Rich Cuzzo, Jr. (112); Josh Sturm, Fr. (119) and Josh Hurlburt, Sr. (145).

LeRoy coach Bob Gately will have his hands full defending last year's title. Ryan Alexander, Sr. (140) returns to defend his championship. Mike Gale, Soph. (103); Matt Riggi, Sr. (160); Jason Saeva, Sr. (171); and Brian Shum, Sr. (189) should place for LeRoy.

Coach Rick Scoville of Geneseo has four individual wrestlers who can place for the Blue Devils. Greg Scoville, Jr. (112); Andrew Dietsche, Sr. (160); Jeremiah Mann, Sr. (215); and Nathan Pollock, Sr. (189) will score points.

Dansville, coached by Ralph Perry, have three wrestlers to watch. Bobby Miner, Sr. (130); Chris Stauffer, Jr. (112); and Bill Clark, Sr. (135) can place for the Mustangs.

The Avon Braves and first year coach Jason Smith have two wrestlers with the ability to place. Matt Kyle, Sr. (189) and Mike Jefferies, Sr. (171) can score.

Keshequa has Matt Wolfe, Sr. (152) and senior Mark Grover (135) trying to place for the Indians.

The Rams of Bath, coached by John Keddy, have three possible place winners. Andy Gugliotta, Sr. (135); Jeff Baroody, Sr. (171); and Jeff Edsall, Jr. (189).

The Cougars of HF-L also have three potential place finishers. Andy Smith, Soph., (119); Scott Smith, 8<sup>th</sup> (103); Owen Carpenter, Sr. (171) will place for coach Earl Lubitow.

The York Golden Knights coached by Marv Shimmel, have Kyle Kem, Sr. (119) and Phil Butterfield, Sr. (275) who can place.

Wrestling on Fri. 2/4 begins at 5:00, on Saturday wrestling begins at 11:00 a.m. special awards at 5:30 and finals begin at 6:00.

## LCAA WRESTLING HALL OF FAME

In 1996 League Chairman, Sam Linsner, and the LCAA Tournament committee announced the creation of the **LCAA Wrestling Hall of Fame**. The Hall of Fame was established in order to honor those whom through their dedication to the sport of wrestling and to those boys who have participated in it, have built a foundation of excellence that is today the LCAA Wrestling League. The members:

**Mr. Ray Connell** – founding member of the LCAA: former Livonia Coach, started wrestling program at Livonia 1956 – 1957 season. Former wrestling official. First inductee and current president of Livonia Wrestling Hall of Fame.

**Mr. Joe Gustainis** – former Cal-Mum coach; two sectional team titles; five LCAA team titles; eight section five champions; coached MVP of the state tournament (Robin Parker – 1976); President of Section five officials 1983 – 1985.

**Mr. James Jackson** – Cam-Mum wrestler: four time LCAA Champion (1966 – 1969), LCAA Outstanding Wrestler (1968), four time section five qualifier; graduate U.S. Naval Academy (varsity letter - wrestling); Coach – coached three Olympic Wrestlers, USA Military Team (World Championship (1976).

**Mr. John Ordiway** – wrestler: (Wellsville High School 1949 – 1953) Sectional title 1953; Coach: first wrestling coach at Dansville (1957 – 1963), built an outstanding, almost legendary, program. Wrestling official. Section five Outstanding Wrestler Award is titled the Ordiway Award.

**Mr. Dwight Cartwright** – Keshequa wrestler (1969 – 1972), 84 – 4; four time Section Five Class B Champion; two time Section Five Champion, New York State Tournament: Third place (1971), First place (1972), NY State Tournament's Outstanding Wrestler Award (1972); National co-record holder: number of pins in a season (1971); Sports Illustrated Award of Merit (1972); Amateur News Outstanding Wrestler in the United States (1972)

**Mr. Andy Uveino** – Letchworth wrestler (1963 – 1966); four time Wyoming County Champion; two time Hornell Tournament champion; one time Section V Runner-up; three time Section V Champion; high school record: 86-3; (1967) U.S. Army Light Heavyweight Champion, record 33-0.

**Mr. Gary Kreily** – Dansville wrestler (1963 – 1966); four time Hornell Tournament Champion; two time Cal-Mum Holiday Tournament Champion; three time County Tournament Champion; two time Section V Champion; MOW at County Tournament and Hornell Tournament; overall wrestling record: 85-0.

**Mr. John G. Finster** – Graduate of Ithaca College 1957); legendary Livonia Wrestling Coach (15 years); Chairman Livingston County Wrestling Association (six years); Coached many LCAA and Section V champions; coached three state tournament qualifiers, including a state finalist. Member of the Livonia Wrestling Hall of Fame.

**Mr. Anthony Backus** – Livonia wrestler; three time LCAA champion (1967, 1968, 1969); Section V champion (1969); New York State Tournament – second place (1969); Member of the Livonia Wrestling Hall of Fame.

**Mr. Jeffrey N. Cohen** – Overall high school record; 83-6; Runner-up: Caledonia Xmas Tournament; County Tournament; Section V champion; Recipient Ira C. Sapozink Memorial Trophy (top Jewish High School Athlete). Brockport State Wrestler (24-1); outstanding wrestler in NYSSACS championship; RIT Invitational champion; Lifetime record: 107-7.

**Mr. Mike Fuller** – Overall high school record (1972 – 1976): 125-23; LCAA champion; 2-time Section V Class A champion; Section V champion (1976); NYS Tournament second place (1976); SUNY Alfred team captain (1976 0 1978); led team to NJCAA All American; Record holder – most career wins in a National Championship (19); 84 collegiate victories; inducted into SUNY Alfred Athletic Hall of Fame (1993); coaching: Lyndonville High School (1991 – 1998).

**Mr. Kelly Nelson** – Letchworth wrestling coach (1955 – 1963); overall coaching record 90-15-2; coached 34 individual county champions, 12 individual Sectional champions; Letchworth wrestling won five league championships under his leadership (1955 – 1960).

## ***Wrestling Jargon...***

**Caution:** A warning from the referee for an illegal position, or stalling. A second caution in a match results in a point awarded to the opponent.

**Escape:** A wrestler moves from the bottom position to a neutral position. The wrestler earns one point for each escape.

**Fall / Pin:** A wrestler holds both of the opponent's shoulder blades to the mat for two seconds, thus ending the match.

**Match:** Two wrestlers competing for three two-minute periods.

**Near fall:** A move through which a wrestler exposes one or both of his opponent's shoulders to the mat. The wrestler earns two points for holding this position for at least two seconds, or three points for holding this position for at least five seconds.

**Neutral position:** The starting position in which both wrestlers are on their feet, and neither wrestler has control.

**Referee's position:** The starting position in which one wrestler kneels and places both hands on the mat in front of him, and the other wrestler assumes a position on top of his opponent with one knee on the mat, and one hand on his opponent's elbow.

**Reversal:** A move through which a wrestler in the bottom position can get behind or on top of his opponent and controls him. The wrestler earns two points for a reversal.

**Stalemate:** Both wrestlers are declared to be in a deadlock situation. The wrestlers are brought back to the referee's position and restarted.

**Stalling:** A wrestler is cautioned for not advancing his position.

**Takedown:** A move through which a wrestler is maneuvered or thrown to the mat from the neutral position and maintains a controlling position.

### **Team scoring:**

- Decision (win by 7 points or less) = 3 team points
- Major Decision (win by 8-11 points) = 4 team points
- Superior Decision (win by 12-14 points) = 5 team points
- Technical Fall (win by 15 points or more) = 6 team points
- Pin/Fall = 6 team points
- Forfeit = 6 team points
- Disqualification = 6 team points
- Default = 6 team points

**Weight classes:** High school wrestlers compete in 15 weight classes: 96 (tournaments only), 103, 112, 119, 125, 130, 135, 140, 145, 152, 160, 171, 189, 220, 275 (tournaments only). A 2 lb. weight allowance is given 1/1/97; an additional 1 lb. weight allowance is given 2/1/97.
