

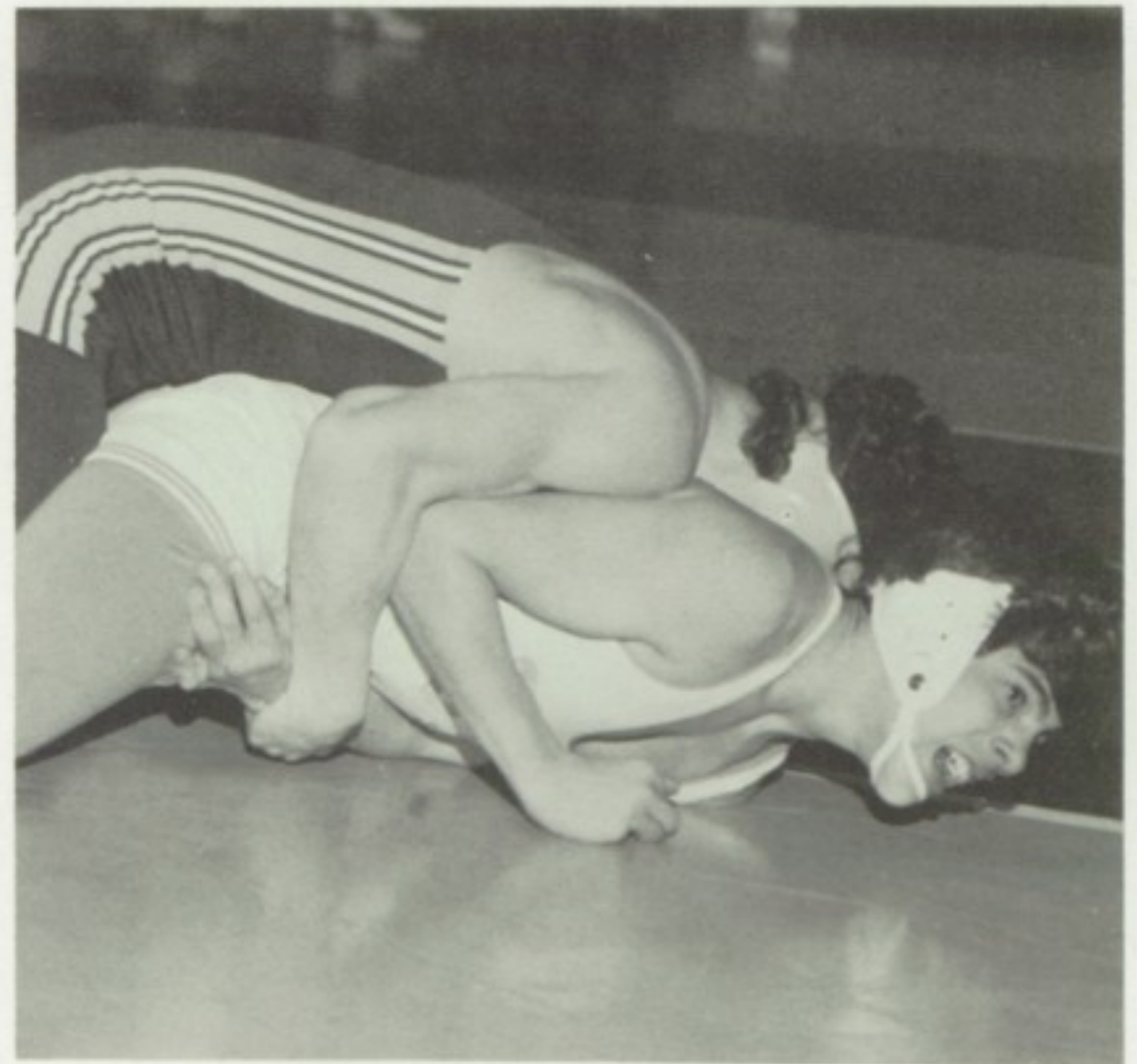

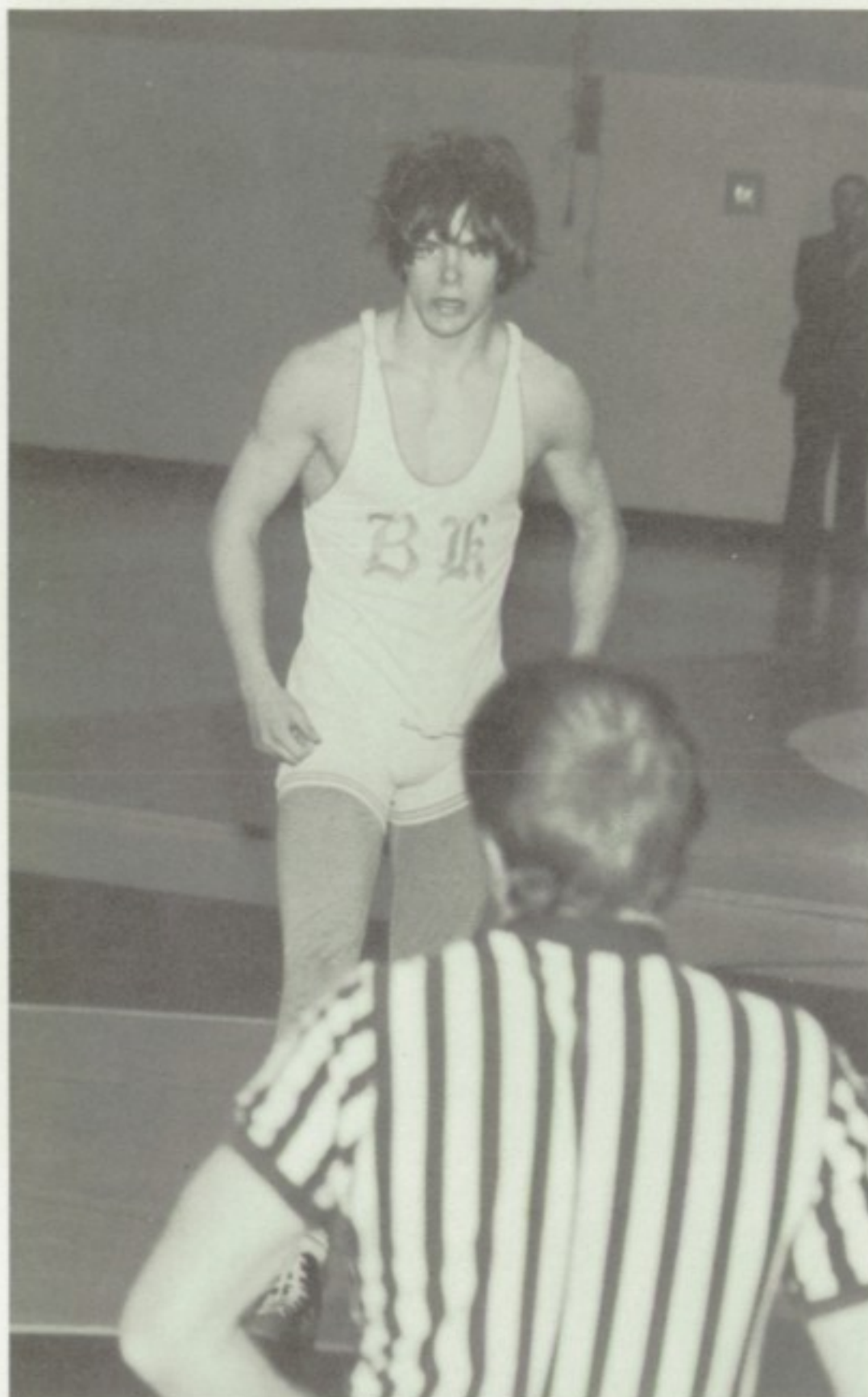
John Bellomo breaks his opponent's stance.

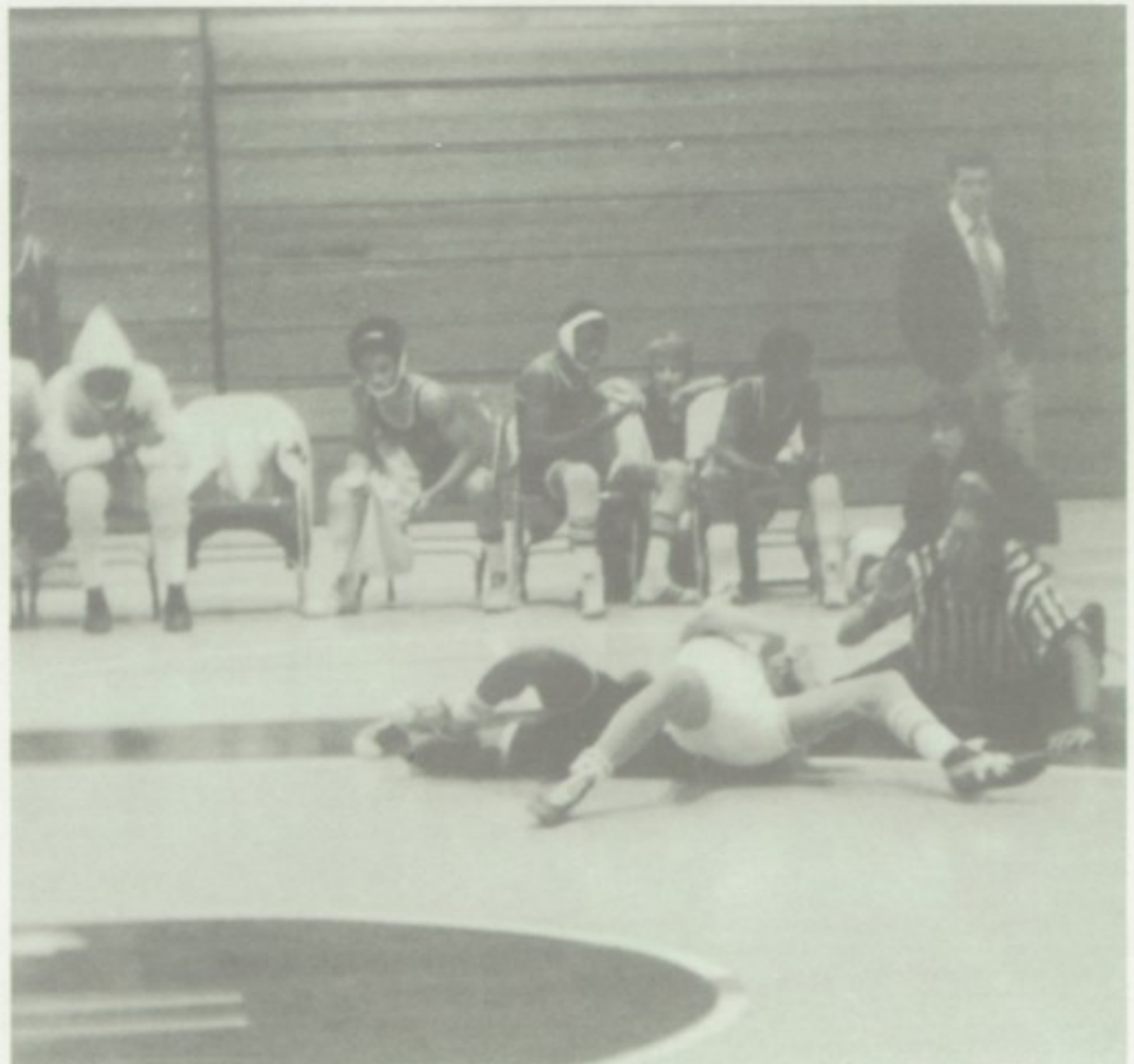
