## Varsity grapplers continue winning tradition.

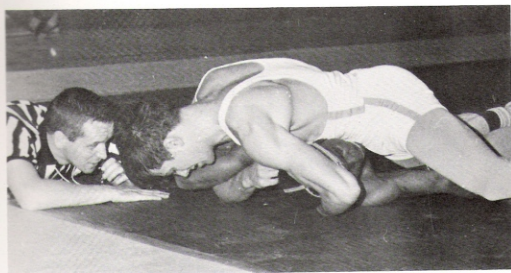

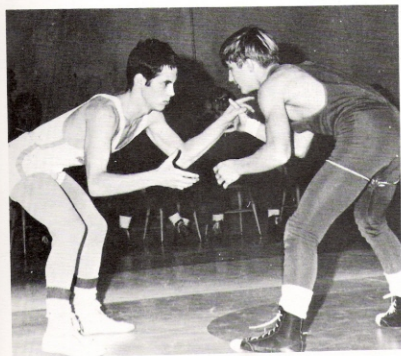

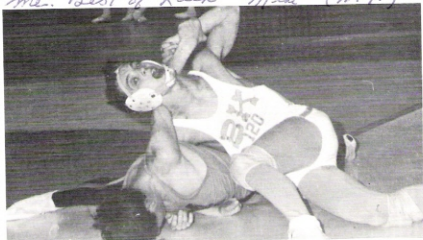

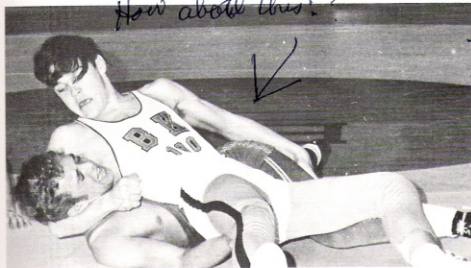
