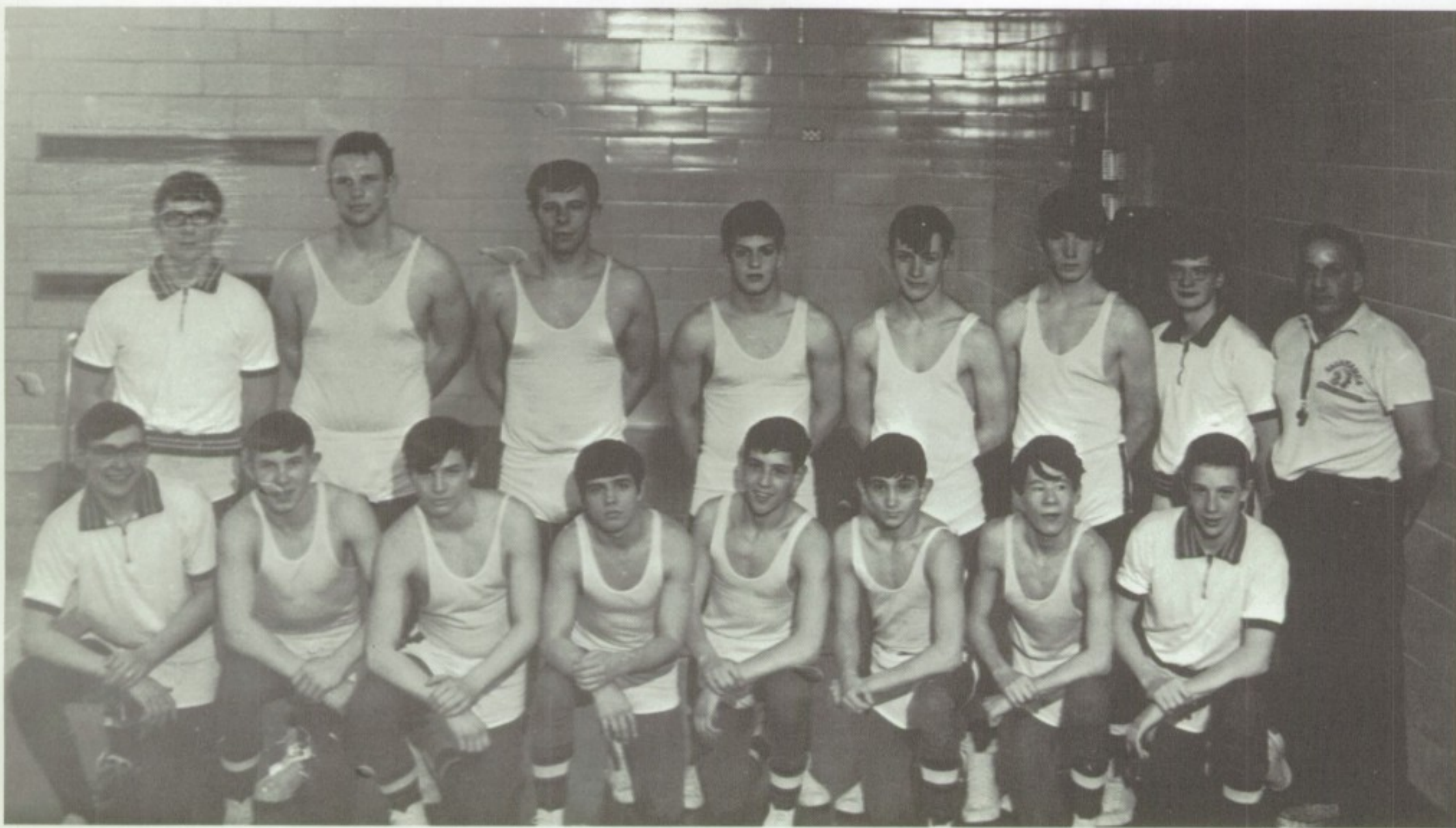
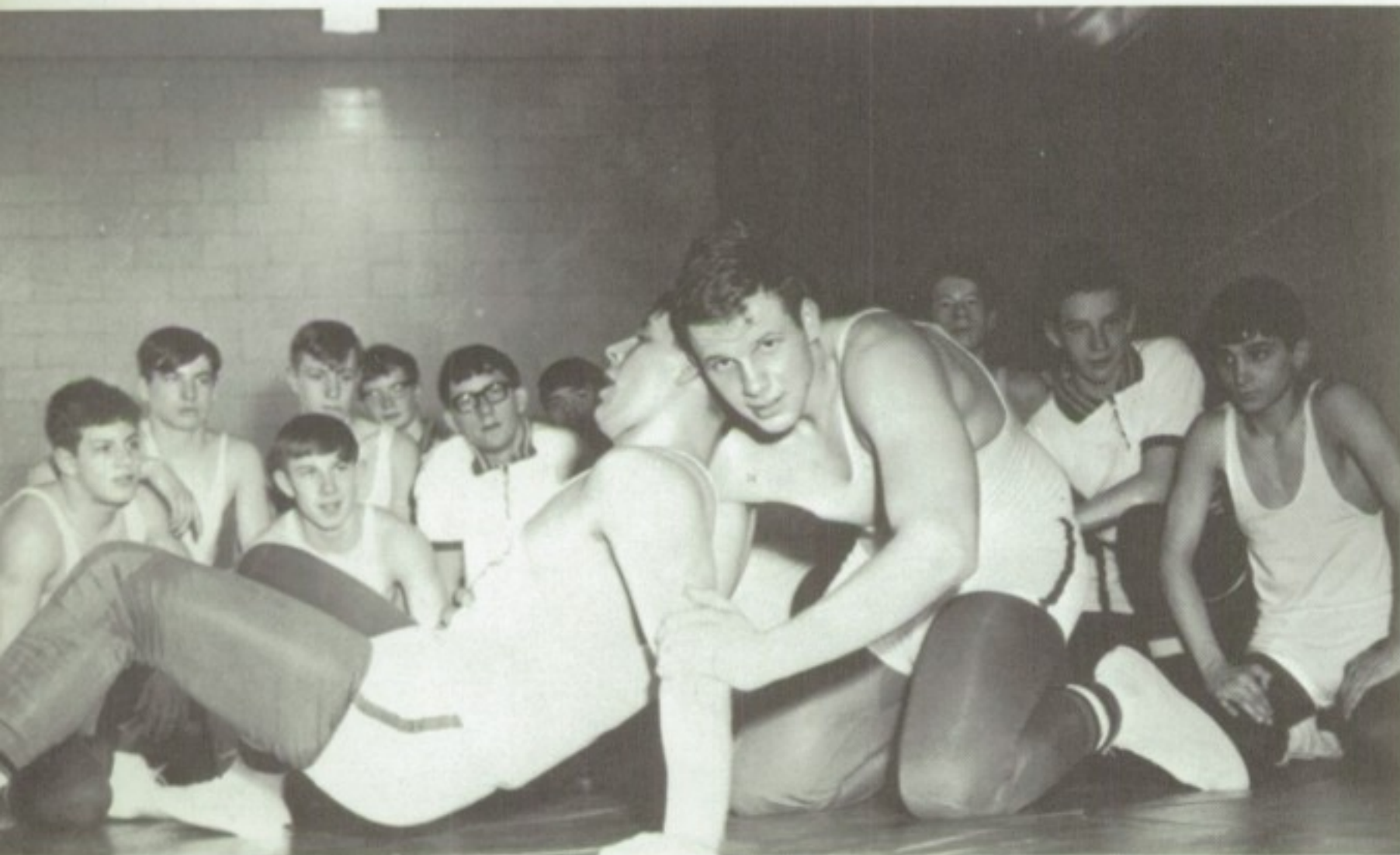

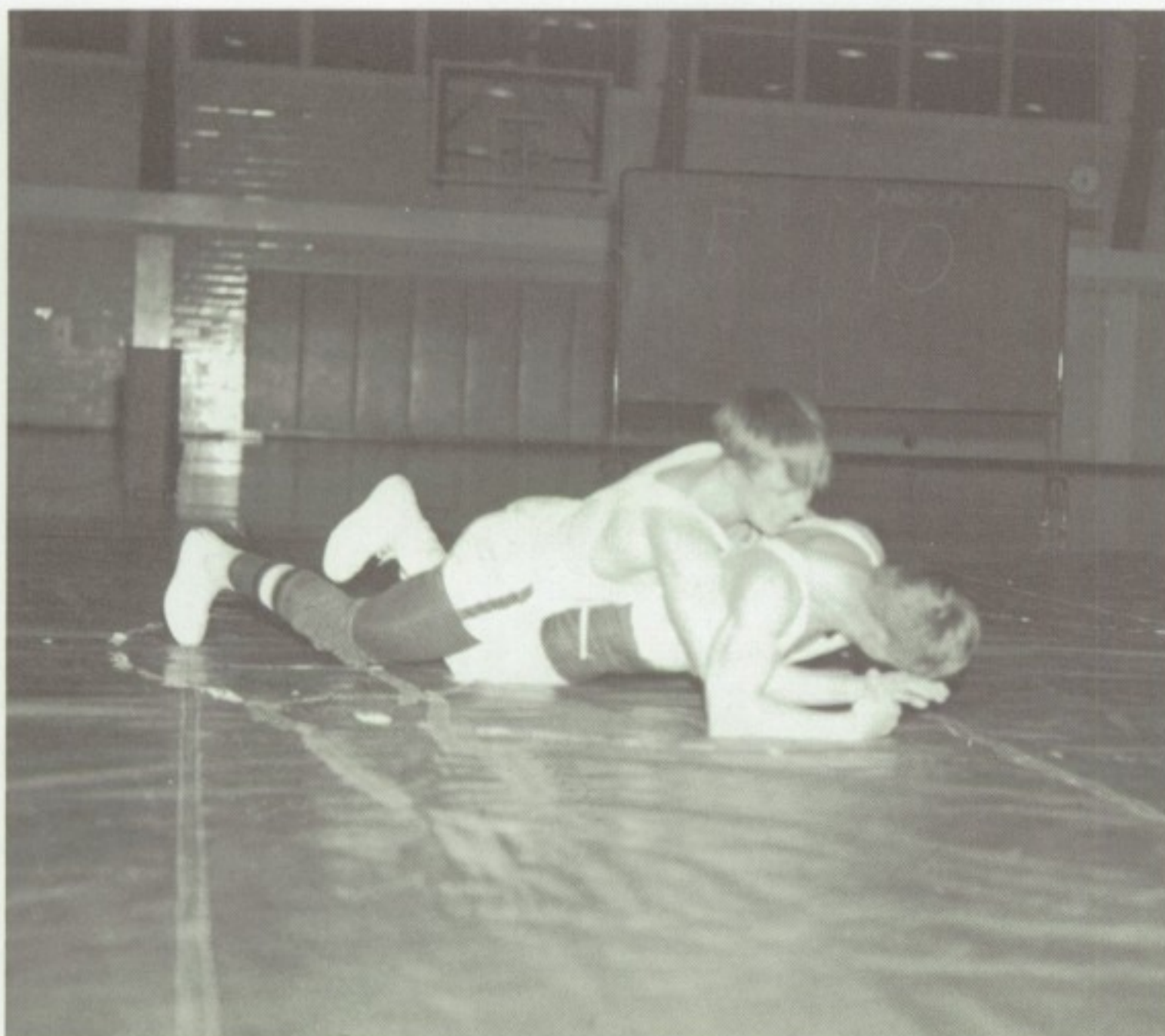


Gordon Bromley demonstrates a strong hold on teammate Tom Meyers.
