CROSS COUNTRY

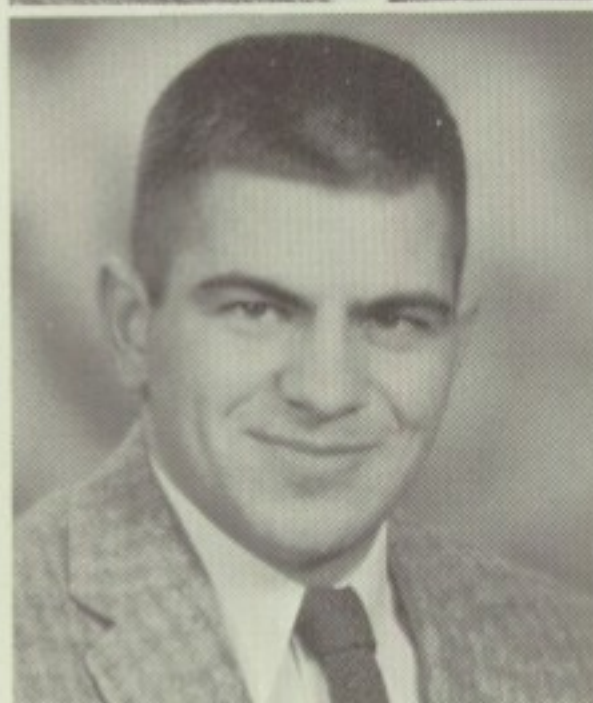
