Dansville wrestlers smother Livonia on Senior Night

Mustangs also lose to Warsaw; place third in Spectator Classic

DANSVILLE — The Dansville wrestling team travelled to Warsaw last Tuesday, Jan. 24, and got bit by the Tigers. The final score of the meet was Warsaw 42, Dansville 23.

After losing the first six matches and falling behind 33-0, the points started going to the Mustangs' side of the scoreboard. Tatter Kysor put the first team points up with a technical decision of 15-0.

Greg Sutfin then added six points with a technical decision of 17-2.

Bobby Taylor gave the Mustangs five points with a major decision of 14-1, and Joe "Spiderman" Lippens registered the only pin of the night in 1:32.

Losing to pins were Mike "The Muscle" Foster, Jake "The Snake" Reisinger, Donnie Adams, Kaleb Ebert and Jake "Cannonball" Campbell.

Andy Miner lost a hard-fought decision of 10-5 and Ben "No More Mr. Nice Guy" Kysor lost a close 2-0 decision.

Thursday was the last dual

match of the 1995 season as well as Senior Night at Dansville. Participating seniors Jamie Johnson, Bobby Taylor and Toby Jamison were honored prior to the match for their achievements and goals.

The ensuing match pitted the Mustangs against the Livonia Bulldogs and after a hard-fought battle, the Mustangs emerged with a 55-12 victory.

Recording pins for the Mustangs were: Mike Foster at 98 lbs. in 2:50; Don "Comer" Kephart at 126 lbs. in 4:22; Tatter Kysor at 138 lbs. in 3:36; Ben Kysor at 145 lbs. in 1:10; and the quickest pin of the night was recorded by Greg Sutfin at 155 lbs. in only 49 seconds.

Andy Miner at 119 lbs. and Bobby Taylor at 167 lbs. each recorded technical fall decisions.

Joe Lippens won by a major decision of 15-3 at 177 lbs.; Jake

Reisinger won by a 10-3 decision at 105 lbs. and Craig "Scooter" June received a forfeit.

Losing to pins were Jamie "Psycho" Johnson and Kaleb Ebert.

Chad "Rollie" VanAuken had the only pin for the Mustang J.V. team.

The Mustangs spent all day Saturday in Hornell at the Spectator Classic Wrestling Tournament. Dansville was very well represented with 12 of their 13 wrestlers bringing home trophies for finishing sixth or better in their weight classes.

— Nate VanLare at 91 lbs. and Craig June at 215 lbs. finished sixth.

— Comer Kephart at 126 lbs., Tatter Kysor at 138 lbs. and Ben Kysor at 145 lbs. finished fifth.

— Jamie Johnson at 119 lbs. and Greg Sutfin at 155 lbs.

finished fourth. Sutfin also had the quickest pin of the tournament in only 18 seconds!

— Jake Reisinger at 105 lbs. won his consolation semifinal match to finish third.

— Mike Foster at 98 lbs., Conan Miner at 112 lbs., Bobby Taylor at 167 lbs. and Spider Man Lippens at 177 lbs. went into the final round. Of the four, Bobby Taylor brought home the only championship trophy.

The team finished with 185.5 points and the third place team trophy. Hornell finished first with 281 points and Addison was second with 220 points.

Keshequa was also one of the 10 teams to compete.
