

Mynderse grapplers closing in on West title Seigfried, Jackson lead Blue Devils to brink of championship

By Mark Adair The Mynderse wrestling team has run off nine straight victories to open the season. The Blue Devils are 6-0 in league matches and are in a position to claim the Finger Lakes West championship.

"We've never had a team undefeated this late in the season," Mynderse coach Kirk Ward said. "It's exciting. It's fun and it makes the winter go along a little faster. "

But Ward doesn't encourage any celebrating yet.

We have an opportunity to do something real nice," Ward said, "but we haven't achieved it yet and by no means will that be easy to do."

The Blue Devils have been led all season by a pair of seniors that are undefeated and hoping to make a run at a berth in the state championships this 1 Ottenfel March.

Scott Seigfried, a 112pounder, is at 19-0 this season and recently picked up his 100th career win as he took home the title at the Pal-Mac Invitational Tournament.

Seigfried has wrestled at the varsity level since he was an eighthgrader and he has been to the Super Sectional meet the last four years.

"I really want to go on to the states this season," Seigfried said. "It's still a little ways off though. We are just starting to gear up for the league championships and the Sectionals." Ward says that Seigfried has

the credentials.

"He has been one of the top eight wrestlers in his weight class for the past four years," he said. "He's definitely a contender to go to the states. He has the talent but there are four or five other kids who have the talent too. It will come down to one weekend in late February."

Jeff Jackson, a 177-pounder, is 18-0 this season.

"Jeff is in his third year of varsity wrestling and he has worked real hard to get good at wrestling," Ward said. "I think that he has a shot to go to the state's too."

Jackson is a three-sport star at Mynderse.

He was named to the First Team Central Division All-Star team at both defensive end and at offensive guard this past fall. Jackson also made it to the state qualifying track meet last spring as a shot putter. He placed fourth

Jackson is excited about the chance the team has at finishing the season undefeated.

Seigfried stated that it really has been a "total team effort" in staying unbeaten.

"A lot of guys are doing the little things that help us win matches," he said. "In wrestling, even if you lose your own match. you can help the team. You can save three points by not getting pinned and a lot of guys are doing that this season."



But while both wrestlers are quick to compliment teammates - Ward is just as quick to compliment the two seniors.

The veteran coach of the Mynderse Academy wrestling team watched as his Blue Devils race to a commanding 28-9 lead against visiting South Seneca in a key Finger Lakes West match last night. The 145-pound bout was on tap.

Three matches later, the lead wasn't so commanding. It was 28-23 and Ward was feeling a little anxious.

"We told our kids it could turn out this way," Ward said after the match. "We could jump to a lead and they could come all the way back."

As it turned out, Ward's worries were put to rest by star 177-pounder Jeff Jackson. With a solid 7-0 decision in his match, Jackson gave the Blue Devils an insurmountable lead in a 31-27 win that kept Mynderse (9-0 overall, 6-0 league) unbeaten and on top in the West.

For South Seneca (5-2, 5-2), which shared the league title with Marcus Whitman last season, it was a case of too little too late as their championship hopes were dealt a serious blow.

"I knew it was going to be a close match," Falcons coach Dave Poulsen said. "I guess we'll have to shoot for the league tourney now and know we have everybody back next year."

SS did get off to a good start as 98pounder Jason Hardy dominated Gary French from the opening whistle and eventually recorded a pin at the 3:40 mark. But the Falcons gave the six points right back when they forfeited to Guy Turner at 105.





Tight finish — Wayne upset HS wrestling eads to 3-way tie for title

Geneva clinches share of first title since '71

After a pounding at the hands of Geneva eight days ago, Wayne Central wrestling coach Scott Freischlag assessed his team's chances in last night's season-closing showdown at Canandaigua.

"I don't know if we have enough to stay with them," the fourth-year coach said following Geneva's 42-18 victory against his Eagles.

Geneva's convincing win seemingly had given senior-laden Canandaigua - unbeaten in dual meets since 1993 - the inside track. to a Finger Lakes East championship. Apparently, the Panthers delivered a wake-up call to Wayne.

Sparked by Aaron Malbone's key one-point decision, the Eagles stunned the Braves 29-27 last night in front of a packed house at Canandaigua Academy. Canandaigua, ranked eighth in the state, was favored to take its first

outright title this decade but instead will share the crown with Wayne and Geneva, ranked 20th and 12th in the state poll, respectively.

Canandaigua and Wayne shared the title last season; Geneva, by virtue of its 36-24 win over Marion last night, gained a share of its first crown since 1971.
