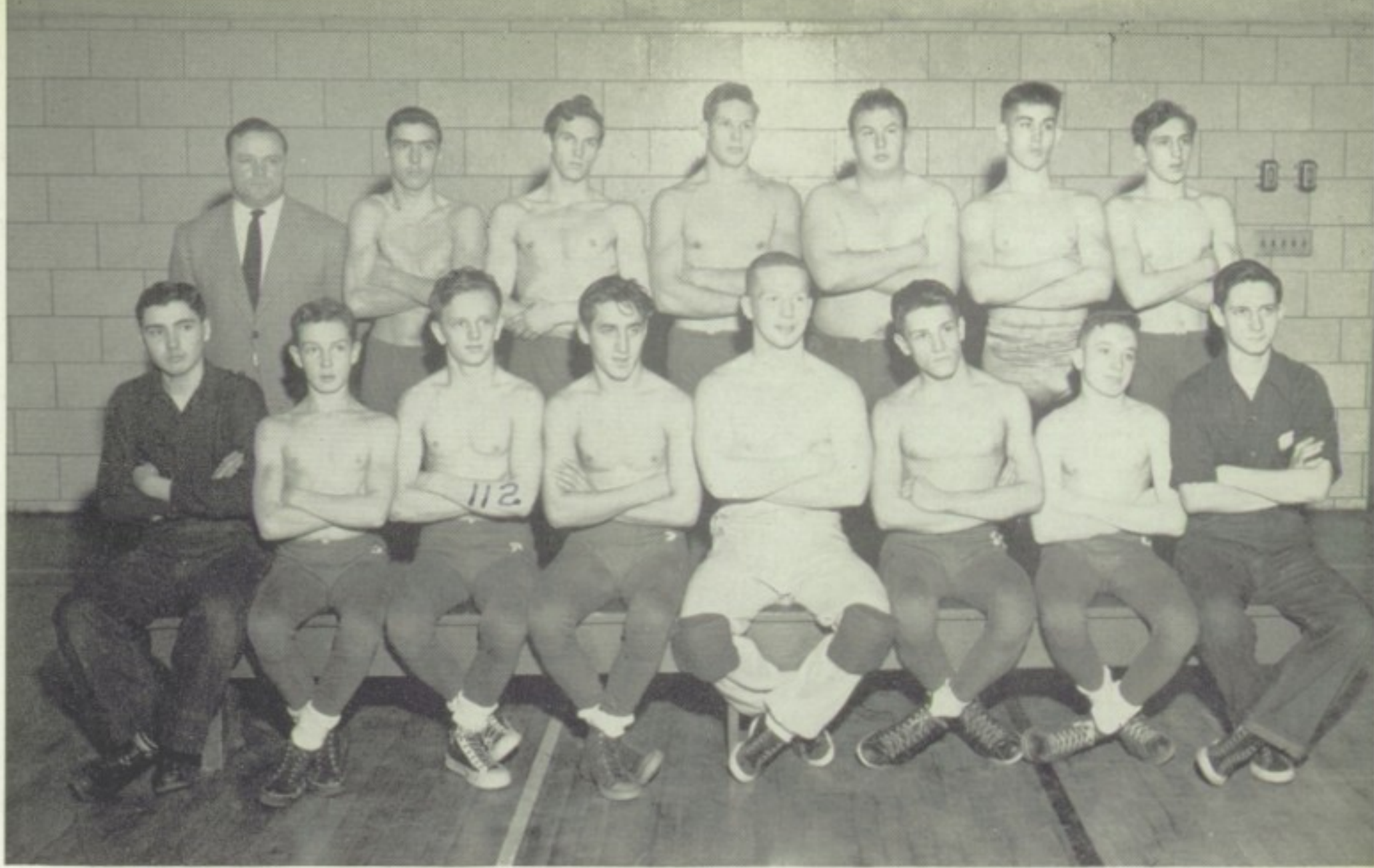

WRESTLING

This year, the Academy wrestling squad came under the supervision of our newest arrival at E. F. A., Coach Marty Harrigan.
