Wrestling Team

This was a busy year for the P.S.C. wrestlers, under the direction of Coach Kenneth Martin. Only four veterans returned to the team as the balance of the squad was made up of newcomers.

The only home match was held on January 17 when the P.S.C. boys tied Queen University 18 to 18. For the first time in several years the Belknap met Albany State College on February 9. In the past Albany has gone away the victor, but this year the boys managed to hold the leaders to a 20-20 tie.

In connection with the Saranac Lake Winter Carnival the Cats were matched with McGill University. The team came off in a fine victory by a score of 23 to 8.

Two more matches were won from Orange County Community College.

The next two matches were not as successful for on February 11, Mount College defeated us 21 to 7 and the next day the Alfred Aggies took top honors with 24 points to our 9.

The wrestling Belknap returned to the winners circle when they met Queen University at Kingston, Ontario, Canada, on February 18, bringing home 14 points to their 6.
