The IOC said the reasoning behind pulling wrestling was that the sport had failed to modernize, as well as a lack of fan interest. The decision caused an international outcry and prompted the United States, Russia, Iran and other countries to join forces in a bid to bring the sport back.

While Olympic wrestling was given its biggest wake-up call of its 3,000-year-old life, its leadership reinvented and reinvigorated itself – changing the rules and giving itself a makeover. On Sept. 8, 2013, the IOC voted to reinstate wrestling into the Olympics – giving wrestling a rebirth.
